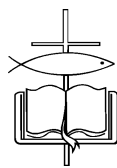


Friday, February 10, is the feast of St. Scholastica, twin sister of St. Benedict. This is a very special day for the Benedictine Sisters of Sacred Heart Monastery in Yankton and for Benedictines world-wide. Scholastica and Benedict often had conversations about heaven. At the moment of her death, Benedict saw a white dove ascend from her convent. The Benedictine Sisters are among the oldest religious orders in the Catholic Church and have done much in the areas of education, health care and evangelization for centuries.

Saturday, February 11, is the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. It is a day observed around the world to emphasize the Church's compassion for the sick and our concern for them and their families.

The facts about the thousands of miracles at Lourdes include Archbishop Robert Carlson who attributes the healing of his bladder cancer to the healing waters of Lourdes. The walkways to the church there are lined with abandoned crutches, wheelchairs and other items left behind by those who were cured in the miraculous waters of the pool. The story, *Song of Bernadette*, tells us about how the young girl, Bernadette Soubirous, saw visions of the Blessed Mother from February 11 to July 16, 1858. She herself died of tuberculosis of the bone before she was 25 years old. It was during the visions at Lourdes that the Virgin made a statement: "I am the Immaculate Conception." This came less than three years after the doctrine of the Immaculate Conception was defined by the Church, something that a young girl in a small French village could not have known. The body of St. Bernadette is displayed in a glass coffin in Nevers, France. The site of the apparitions in Lourdes is one of the largest pilgrimage sites in Europe, hosting thousands of visitors every day.

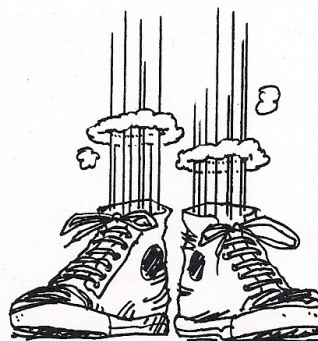
