

## **Minutes to the May 11, 2011 St. Leo's Parish Council Meeting** Unapproved at this time

St. Leo's Parish Council met on Wednesday May 11, 2011 at 6pm at the Father Cronin Center. Members present were: Greg Schneider, Dee Rothschadl, Marian Peschl, Bobbi Zimmerman, Ed Mitzel, Ron Zimmerman, Gary LaCompte and Father Gerald Thury. Father Thury called the meeting to order in the absence of Council President John Cihak and opened with a prayer. Council Secretary Greg Schneider read the minutes of the April meeting. Gary motioned and Ron seconded to accept the minutes as read. Motion carried unanimously.

**Financial Report:** Father gave the Financial Report for April 2011. Net Income was \$+9,542.72. CFSA to date is \$21,400.00 total of which \$2,720.00 was pledged. This is 80% of St. Leo's goal of \$26,600.00 and approximately 50% of the total cards turned in. Father also reported the KC's gave \$300.00 to the Parish for the Fish Frys.

**Old Business:** Father reported that Holy Week attendance at Mass seemed higher this year. Gary LaCompte will return to the Board for another term so there will be no new nominations this year.

Father reported not much done yet with the summer repairs. Altar Society President Bobbi Zimmerman reported that the Altar Society to donate to the bathroom project.

**New Business:** After some discussion it was the consensus of Father and the Board not to hold the Parish Appreciation Dinner year due to continuing low attendance at the previous dinner and also because it is getting late in the year. It was decided to look at other ways to show the Parish's appreciation for everyone's hard work. Father also announced the resignation Of CCD Coordinator Shelly Scieszinski. Father and the Board also discussed giving JoLynn Weber a Thank You gift for her dedication and hard work with the CCD program. Motion by Ed, seconded by Marian to give JoLynn a monetary gift of \$200 or \$250. Motion carried. Father also discussed with the Board the liability policy for use of the facilities such as Father Cronin Center. It was decided to take a serious look at the policy instituted at St. Vincent's. Father reported that to date the Parish spent \$12,191.00 on propane this winter. On behalf of the Parish, The Board commended Elton Rokusek for receiving the KC Knight of the Year Award. Dee and Marian brought up the idea of having ushers for funerals. Father announced to the Board his intentions on retiring from the active Priesthood this July and a new Pastor to be assigned to St. Leo's

Next meeting tentatively scheduled for Wednesday June 8<sup>th</sup> at 6pm. Father asked for a motion to adjourn. Ed motioned and Ron seconded. Father closed
